

Articulated, nanofigure-scaled Star Wars AT-AT diorama

BUILDING GUIDE

Hello, this is a building guide for a fully articulated, nanofigure-scaled Star Wars AT-AT diorama, featuring two Snowspeeders. While the assembly is pretty straightforward, especially if you have already installed the Lego Digital Designer, there are a few things that are worth being explained.

This model, while not that fragile, is mainly for display. Also, it does not pretend to be “nano-scaled”, it is scaled (roughly) at the scale of a nanofigure part (aka “trophy”).

It has built-in light support, requiring a light brick, but it is of course optional.

The Snowspeeders are slightly fragile, unless you replace the 1x2 grill part by a 1x3 tile, which will of course look inferior (unless you wanna bother printing that tile to feature the 2 canopy hatches and the back gun).

As for the building guide, it is required that you install the Lego Digital Designer, available at

www.ddd.lego.com.

You could use the LDD's built-in instruction creator, but I would rather suggest you build from what you see, hiding the necessary groups.
